- **12 DO NOT** use the appliance if there is damage to the power cord or plug. Regularly inspect the appliance and power cord. If the appliance malfunctions or has been damaged in any way, immediately stop use and call Customer Service.
- 13 NEVER use socket below worktop surface.
- **14 DO NOT** place appliance and let cord hang over edges of tables, worktops or touch hot surfaces.
- **15** Only use recommended accessories included with this appliance or authorised by SharkNinja. The use of accessories or attachments not recommended by SharkNinja may cause a risk of fire or injury.
- 16 Before placing any accessory on the grill, ensure they are clean and dry.
- **17 DO NOT** move the appliance when in use or when hot oils and hot liquids are in the product
- **18 DO NOT** touch hot surfaces. Appliance surfaces are hot during and after operation. To prevent burns or personal injury, **ALWAYS** use protective hot pads or insulated oven gloves and use available handles and knobs.
- **19 DO NOT** touch accessories during or immediately after cooking. The grill plates become extremely hot during the cooking process. Avoid physical contact while removing these from the appliance. To prevent burns or personal injury **ALWAYS** use care when using the product. Recommend use of long-handled utensil and protective hot pads or insulated oven gloves.
- 20 DO NOT use this appliance for deep-frying.
- **21** To prevent possible illness, **ALWAYS** use a food thermometer to check that your food is cooked to the recommended temperatures.
- **22** Should a grease fire occur or the unit emits black smoke, unplug immediately. Wait for smoking to stop before removing any cooking accessories.
- **23** Please refer to the Cleaning & Maintenance section for regular maintenance of the appliance.
- **24** To disconnect, turn unit to "OFF," then unplug from socket when not in use and before cleaning.
- **25** Allow to cool before cleaning, disassembling, putting in or taking off parts, or storing.
- **26 DO NOT** clean with metal scouring pads. Pieces can break off the pad and touch electrical parts, creating a risk of electric shock.
- **27** The supply cord cannot be replaced. If the cord is damaged the appliance should be responsibly disposed of as electronic waste.

- **29** Cleaning and use maintenance shall not be done by children.

GETTING TO KNOW THE NINJA SIZZLE PRO XL INDOOR GRILL AND FLAT PLATE



BEFORE FIRST USE

- 1 Remove and discard any packaging material, stickers, and tape from the unit.
- 2 Remove all accessories from the package and carefully read the manual before use. Please pay particular attention to operational instructions, warnings, and important safeguards to avoid any injury or property damage.
- **3** Wash the grill plate with a damp, soapy cloth, then wipe with a clean, damp cloth and dry thoroughly. **NEVER** submerge the main unit in water.
- 4 We recommend turning the unit on and running it on 260°C for 10 minutes without adding food. Make sure the area is well ventilated. This removes any packaging residue and odor traces that may be present. This is completely safe and not detrimental to the performance of the grill.

HOW TO HAVE LOW-SMOKE EXPERIENCE

Always use the recommended grill settings. Our chef-designed temperature settings maximize grill flavors and textures while minimizing smoke.

160°C	175°C	200°C	260°C

If using oil or fat during the cooking process, we recommend using oils with high smoke points. For best results, Sunflower, Refined Coconut, Avocado, Vegetable, or Grapeseed oils are recommended.Olive Oil, Butter, Margarine, or aerosol cooking sprays are NOT recommended.

COOKING WITH GRILL/FLAT PLATE MODE

- 1 To install the grill or flat plate, position it over the base with the grease chimney toward the front. Place the grill plate down, ensuring the sides align with the exterior of the base.
- 2 Make sure the unit is plugged in, push the power button.
- **3** The unit will default to Grill/Flat Plate Mode.
- **4** Use the dial to select Low, Medium, High, or Sear (Grill only), or use the TemplQ to turn the dial to your specific temperature.

5 Press the Time button and use the dial to program your time. When finished, press the START/STOP button to start preheating.

6 After preheating is complete, the unit will beep and display "ADD FOOD". Push the START/ STOP button to start the timer, or wait 15 seconds and it will start automatically.

CLEANING YOUR GRILL

The unit should be cleaned thoroughly after each use. Always let the appliance cool before cleaning.

- 1 Unplug the unit from the wall outlet before cleaning. Keep the lid open after removing your food to allow the unit to cool quicker.
- 2 To prolong the nonstick coating of the grill plate, we recommend hand-washing in warm, soapy water then air- or towel-drying all parts. The splatter lid is dishwasher safe.

NOTE: When cleaning the grease catch, let the oil cool and then easily scrape off.

TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE

- **3** If food residue or grease is stuck on the grill plate, splatter lid, or any other removable part, soak in warm, soapy water before cleaning.
- **4** To clean the base heating unit of the grill, use a damp, soapy cloth, then wipe with a clean, damp cloth and dry thoroughly.

NOTE: NEVER use abrasive tools or cleaners. **NEVER** immerse the main unit in water or any other liquid. Do not place in dishwasher.

NOTE: Ninja Sizzle Pro XL Indoor Grill and Flat Plate can be used with the lid open or closed.

CUSTOM TEMP INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 To install the grill or griddle plate, position it over the base with the grease chimney toward the front. Place the grill plate down, ensuring the sides align with the exterior of the base.
- 2 Make sure the unit is plugged in, push the power button.
- 3 Use the Mode button to select Custom Temp.
- **4** The unit will default to 180C. Use the dial to choose your desired temperature from a range of 160-260C.
- 5 Press the Time button and use the dial to program your time. The unit will default to 15 minutes. When finished, press the START/STOP button to start preheating.
- 6 After preheating is complete, the unit will beep and display "ADD FOOD". Push the START/STOP button to start the timer, or wait 15 seconds and it will start automatically.

INSTALLING AND REMOVING THE SPLATTER LID

- 1 After allowing the unit to cool, remove the lid by opening it until it is approximately vertical. Then lift the lid straight up out of the hinge base.
- **2** To install the lid, hold it vertically with the handle facing up and the hinge pivots over the hinge base. Ensure that the flat sections of the hinge pivots are oriented vertically. Lower the lid hinge pivots into the hinge base, then close the lid.

• Why is the unit emitting smoke?

When using the Grill function, always select the recommended temperature setting. Recommended settings can be found in the Quick Start Guide and in the Inspiration Guide. Make sure the splatter shield is installed.

How long are new Ninja machines guaranteed for?

Our manufacturer's guarantee lasts for one year from the date of purchase as standard, or for two years if you register your purchase with us within 28 days.

How do I register my Ninja guarantee?

If you have purchased your Ninja kitchen appliance directly from ninjakitchen.co.uk your guarantee is registered automatically. If you bought it from anywhere else in the UK, you can register your guarantee online within 28 days of purchase.

- Keep a note of the date you purchased the machine.

IMPORTANT:

- Keep your receipt if you bought your Ninja kitchen appliance from anywhere except ninjakitchen.co.uk. You will need it to claim under your guarantee.
- The free Ninja guarantee only applies in the UK.

What are the benefits of registering my free Ninja guarantee?

When you register your guarantee, you will get an extra year of cover. We'll also have your details to hand if we ever need to get in touch. What is covered by the free Ninja guarantee?

Repair or replacement (at Ninja's discretion) of your Ninja machine, including all parts and labour.

What is not covered by the free Ninja guarantee?

- Accidental damage or faults caused by negligent use or care, misuse, neglect, careless operation or handling of the Ninja kitchen appliance which is not in accordance with the Ninja Operating Manual supplied with your machine.
- Damage caused by use of the Ninja kitchen appliance for anything other than normal domestic household purposes.
- Damage caused by use of parts not assembled or installed in accordance with the operating instructions.

- Damage caused by use of parts and accessories which are not Ninja Genuine Components
- Faulty installation (except where installed by Ninja).
- Repairs or alterations carried out by parties other than Ninja or its agents.

The Ninja representative will go through some troubleshooting with you, and if we conclude that the item has failed, we will send you a replacement part or a returns label to send the defective item back to us free of charge. When you have delivered the defective product to us, we will send you a replacement.

Please remember that the item will need to be boxed when you return it to us. It can be any suitable box, it does not have to be the original packaging.

Ninja spares and accessories are developed by the same engineers who developed your Ninja kitchen appliance.
